To request a Military Academy Nomination from my office, please complete this document and mail it to my Tulsa District office (postmarked no later than October 15th) or you may bring to the Tulsa District office during regular working hours on or before the 15th of October. When you mail or bring in your nomination application, all-supporting documents (including letters of recommendation, transcripts, copies of test scores, etc.) must be in the single envelope you provide. It is the candidate's responsibility to ensure that application packet is complete at the time of its submission. Failure to follow the application process could disqualify you from consideration.
